Poets' Roundtable of Arkansas (PRA) is a statewide, non-profit organization established in 1931. It is the oldest poetry organization in the state dedicated to the study of poetry and the encouragement of poets and PRA participates in the National Federation of State Poetry Societies (NFSPS).

PRA is again sponsoring a college student poetry contest in the upcoming year. We are promoting this contest to students across the state and asking college faculty to partner with us in sharing materials with students. THERE IS NO ENTRY FEE. This contest will award the top three winners a total of one thousand dollars (1st--\$500, 2nd--\$300, and 3rd--\$200). Materials are attached and posted on PRA's website. Form: Free verse

Line Limit: No more than 40 lines

Postmark Deadline: March 15, 2019

Awards: First Place \$500, Second Place \$300, Third Place \$200

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CONTEST GUIDELINES

WHO: Arkansas college students, ages 18-25, are invited to participate in PRA's statewide poetry contest for college poets. Applicants must currently be enrolled in Arkansas colleges or universities. The March 15, 2019 postmark deadline will be used as the qualifying date for the age requirement.

WHAT: Students may choose any subject for the poem. Please submit one entry per poet in Free Verse form, within 40 lines. Vulgar language will be disqualified.

WHEN: Entries will be accepted January 1, 2019 through March 15, 2019 (postmarked). Winners will be announced in April.

WHERE: Winners will be invited to receive their awards at PRA's Dr. Lily Peter Spring Celebration in April 2019. Checks will be mailed to winners who cannot attend.

HOW: Prizes will be awarded for: 1st Place \$500, 2nd Place \$300, and 3rd Place \$200. Judges' decisions will be final. Winners' qualifications will be verified before prizes are awarded.

RULES: No entry fee required. Students, ages 18-25, currently enrolled in Arkansas colleges or universities may enter one poem between January 1, 2019 and March 15, 2019 (postmark deadline). Entries must include a completed contest entry form and proof of age (copy of driver's license or other official document showing birthdate). Poem subject - Any; Form - Free Verse; Line Limit - 40; Font - Times New Roman (size 12). Send two copies of the poem, one with no identifying information, one with name/address/email in the top right corner. Poems will not be returned. Incomplete submissions will be disqualified. By submitting a poem, you are declaring that it is your own original work. Plagiarism will be disqualified.
